IECO presents today: Danny Tröger



<u>Danny Tröger</u> is a research associate at the <u>Institute of Regional Science</u> in KIT. He studied geoecology and regional science at KIT, whereby he completed the double master program "Natural Risks and Disaster Risk Reduction" and spent two semesters at the Universidad de Concepción (UdeC) as part of the program. How he relates to the work on <u>Topic 4</u> and <u>Topic 5</u> of IECO was explained by him in an interview with us:

"I conducted several field studies in Chilean Patagonia as part of my graduate work(s). I was concerned with the effects of the increase in forest plantations in the zone. The effects are on the biodiversity, but also the landslides, erosion and wildfires. In a third project, I conducted a qualitative sociological study on the perception of risks from natural hazards such as landslides and local tsunamis. Later on, I worked in the past years as a project engineer for a private firm in the field of decontamination and deconstruction of buildings containing toxic substances and hazardous materials.

When I joined the KIT as a research associate in 2020, I got involved in a project dealing with social and ecological issues related to the development, production and distribution of novel building materials from solid industrial residues in a marginalized neighbourhood, near a large landfill site in Buenos Aires and we are currently working on transferring the findings from this transdisciplinary project to a Chilean site. The results will be presented during the IECO Summer School! At the same time, I am continuing my work on sustainable land use as part of the team for Topic 5, focusing on exchanging methods and experiences, and identifying parallel developments in other countries.

What motivates me to collaborate internationally? I am an explorer and adventurer, following my role model Alexander von Humboldt, and Chile is just the right country for that, with its incredibly diverse natural spaces and warm people"

We are sure that the participants of the Summer School will be very interested in hearing about the project results and we wish Danny a lot of success in his future explorations!

The goal is to help municipalities develop their own local strategies for circular economy and waste management and incorporate them into their municipal development plans.
